

USA Gymnastics - Massachusetts FAQ's

- Entry Fees
 - Pre-Sectional \$36.00 compulsory/PO, \$41.00 optional
 - Theme \$50.00 compulsory/PO, \$55.00 optional
 - Invitationals set at the discretion of the MD
 - Sectionals \$35.00 Levels 5-10
 - States \$50.00 Levels 2-10, \$45.00 PREP Optional
- Gate Fees
 - Pre-Sectional/Sectional \$3.00 adult/\$2.00 children
 - Theme \$5.00 adult/\$3.00 children
 - Invitational at the discretion of the MD
 - States \$7.00 adult/\$5.00 children
- Event Specialists
 - Mobility through levels 7-9 is an 8.5
 - Declaration date to be a specialist is one month prior to state championships in writing to SACC with events noted.
 - Gymnast needs an 8.7 twice in any qualifying meet to qualify for states
 - To qualify to 9/10 Regionals, gymnast needs to score a 9.0 at states
 - There is no opportunity for Level 8 event specialists to qualify to Level 8 Regionals.
- Team Scores
 - Top 4 scores count at Levels 5 and 6
 - Top 3 scores count at Levels 7-10
 - Levels 2-4 and PO will be determined by team size
- How to register for a state sponsored sectional or state meet?
 - Use form provided at massusag.com
 - Email completed form to Michele Archer and appropriate level rep (one form per level)
 - Immediately follow up with check for full payment (payable to MassUSAG). Do not mail entry form, separate check per state meet, multiple checks per envelope are encouraged
 - Incomplete or incorrect forms/checks for combined state meets will be returned and club will be held responsible for any late fees that are incurred.
 - Any coach not listed on your entry form will not be verified for valid membership and will be required to provide proof of membership (ie: printed card) upon checking in to competition.
- After hosting a meet...
 - Return sanction to USA Gymnastics
 - Copy of sanction and ptf to Michele Archer (scanned sanction preferred)
 - Copy of sanction and \$1.00 per gymnast payable to USAG VI and sent to Kathy Ostberg
 - PTF sent to appropriate level representative (must be done within seven days of competition)

Level 6	7-9, 10, 11, 12+
Level 7	7-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14+
Level 8	8-11, 12, 13-14, 15+
Level 9	8-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17+
Level 10	9-14, 15-16, 17+
